Responsible Service of Alcohol Policy

It is the policy of Charlestown Bowling Club to promote the Responsible Service of Alcohol. Our responsible serving practices aim to:

- Prevent underage drinking
- Prevent or manage intoxication and intoxicated behaviour
- Prevent or manage violent or disruptive behaviour
- Prevent drinking and driving

Charlestown Bowling Club will endeavour to prevent underage drinking by insisting on “proof of age”. The only proof of age we accept are:

- Current Photo drivers licence
- Passport
- Proof of age card issued by the RTA

By law it is an offence to sell or supply liquor to any person who is at the time in a state of intoxication or nearing the point of intoxication.

“The state of intoxication can be described as a state in which through intoxicating liquor a person has lost the normal control of their bodily and mental facilities”

Charlestown Bowling Club will ensure that we prevent intoxication by:

- Training staff in the responsible service of alcohol.
- Refusal of service to intoxicated, violent or quarrelsome patrons
- Encouraging customers to have non-alcoholic drinks in between alcoholic drinks.
- Actively marketing low and non-alcoholic drinks.
- Avoiding promotions and practises that encourage excessive consumption of alcohol.

In the interest of safety of our patrons and the community, Charlestown Bowling Club will promote safe transport options.
